

## Department for Transport Severe Weather Recovery Scheme

During the winter of 2013/2014 adverse weather conditions caused widespread flooding and damage across the country. Due to the extremity of the impacts, Central Government established a Severe Weather Recovery Scheme which was aimed at supporting communities and repairing local highway infrastructure.

Knowsley Council received £202,454 to supplement investment in carriageway maintenance improvement. Using this additional funding, the Council Highway's Team were able to complete the following additional schemes:
