Oversubscription Criteria*	Number of Places Allocated
1. Looked After Children and previously Looked After children.	3
2. Baptised Catholic children who have a sibling in school at the time of admission.	24
3. Baptised Catholic children resident in the Parish(es) of St Michael & All Angels, St Joseph and St Laurence, St Mary Mother of God and Saints Peter and Paul.	80
4. Other baptised Catholic children.	4
5. Other children who have a sibling in school at the time of admissions. This includes full, half or step-brothers and sisters, adopted and foster brothers and sisters and children who are living at the same address and are part of the same family unit. This does not include cousins or other family relationships.	34
6. Children attending one of the Catholic feeder primary schools associated with the parishes named in point 3 above – those Catholic primary schools are: St Michael & All Angels, St Joseph The Worker, St Laurence's, St Marie's and Saints Peter and Paul.	34
7. Children from other Christian denominations. Proof of Baptism in the form of a Baptismal Certificate or confirmation in writing that the applicant is a member of their faith community from an appropriate Minister of Religion is required, should a place be offered.	14
8. Children of other faiths. An appropriate Faith Leader will need to confirm in writing that the applicant is a member of their faith group, should a place be offered.	-
9. Other children.	3
