

September 2020 reception class intake Allocation results

Halewood Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School

The above named school was oversubscribed for entry to reception class in September 2020 (i.e. the school received more requests for places than the number of places available to offer)

As a voluntary aided school, the governing body of the school are responsible for setting and applying the oversubscription criteria (or the 'admission policy') in order to determine which children can be offered places and who can not.

The published admission number for this school is **30** – places were allocated as follows:

Children of parents/carers worshipping at another Christian church for which there is no denominational education available within the Ecclesiastical Parish of Halewood and are resident within the Ecclesiastical Parish of Halewood and whose evidence of commitment to the life, work and witness of the church has been verified as strong.	1
8). Children of parents/carers worshipping at another Christian church for which there is no denominational education available within the ecclesiastical parish of Halewood and are resident within the ecclesiastical parish of Halewood and whose evidence of commitment to the life, work and witness of the church has been verified as reasonable.	-
9). Children living the shortest distance from the school	1

***The total number includes any child who's Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) names the school. For 2020 entry this was 1 child.**

The last child to secure a place fell within criterion **9**. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived **0.143** miles from the school (as the crow flies)

After considering all on-time applications this school was full to the admission number.

Late applications could only be added to the waiting list.
