Allocation results

Huyton with Roby Church of England Primary School (Academy)

The above named school was oversubscribed for entry to reception class in September 2020 (i.e. the school received more requests for places than the number of places available to offer)

As a voluntary aided school, the governing body of the school are responsible for setting and applying the oversubscription criteria (or the 'admission policy') in order to determine which children can be offered places and who cannot.

The published admission number for the school is **60** – places were allocated as follows:

Oversubscription Criteria (Admission Policy)¹	Number of places allocated
1. Children currently/previously in the care of the local authority.	-
2. Children whose parents worship regularly at St Michael's, St Bartholomew's and Trinity Churches in Huyton and Roby.	-
3. Children whose parents worship regularly at other Christian Churches in Huyton and Roby	-
4. Children who have an older sibling at the school at the time of admission	28
5. Other applicants	32
Total	60

The last child to secure a place fell within criterion **5**. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived **1.527** miles from the school (as the crow flies).

After considering all on-time applications this school was full to the admission number.

Late applications could only be added to the waiting list.
