Allocation results

Kirkby Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School

The above named school was oversubscribed for entry to reception class in September 2020 (i.e. the school received more requests for places than the number of places available to offer)

As a voluntary aided school, the governing body of the school are responsible for setting and applying the oversubscription criteria (or the 'admission policy') in order to determine which children can be offered places and who can not

The published admission number for this school is **38** – places were allocated as follows:

| Oversubscription Criteria (Admission Policy) ¹ | Number of places allocated |

| 1. Children currently/previously in the care of the local authority | 1 |
| 2. Children with a sibling at the school at the time of admission. | 12 |
| 3. Children of parents/legal guardian who are regular worshipping members of the three churches of Kirkby Team Ministry (St Chad's, St Martins & St Andrews) | 3 |
| 4. Children of parents/legal guardian who are resident in the Ecclesiastical Parish of Kirkby and are regular worshipping members of a Church or faith for which no denominational education is available within the Ecclesiastical Parish of Kirkby | 2 |
| 5. Children living the shortest distance from the school measured in a straight line. | 20 |
| Total | 38 |

The last child to secure a place fell within criterion **5**. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived **0.768 miles** from the school (as the crow flies).

After considering all on-time applications this school was full to the admission number. Late applications could only be added to the waiting list.
