

September 2020 reception class intake

Allocation results

Plantation Community Primary School

The above named school was oversubscribed for entry to reception class in September 2020 (i.e. the school received more requests for places than the number of places available to offer)

As a community school, the local authority are responsible for setting and applying the oversubscription criteria (or the 'admission policy') in order to determine which children can be offered places and who can not.

The published admission number for this school is **60** – places were allocated as follows:

Oversubscription Criteria (Admission Policy) ¹	Number of places allocated
1. Children currently/previously in the care of the local authority	-
2. Children with exceptional medical or welfare needs	-
3. Children with a sibling in the school	18
4. Distance from home to school (as the crow flies)	41
Total	60*

***The total number includes any child whose Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP) names the school. For 2020 entry this was 1 child.**

The last child to secure a place fell within criterion **4**. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived **1.783** miles from the school (as the crow flies).

After considering all on-time applications this school was full to the admission number. Late applications could only be added to the waiting list.
