Allocation results

St Gabriel's Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School (Academy)

The above named school was oversubscribed for entry to reception class in September 2020 (i.e. the school received more requests for places than the number of places available to offer)

As a voluntary aided school, the governing body of the school are responsible for setting and applying the oversubscription criteria (or the 'admission policy') in order to determine which children can be offered places and who can not.

The published admission number for this school is **30** – places were allocated as follows:

Oversubscription Criteria (Admission Policy)¹	Number of places allocated
1. Children currently/previously in care	0
2. Children whose parent(s) are committed members of and who regularly attend worship at St Gabriel's Parish Church, Huyton Quarry	0
3. Children whose parent(s) or carers wish them to have a faith based education, and who regularly attend worship at their own church within the parish of Huyton Quarry	0
4. Children with a brother or sister attending the school at the time of admission	20
5. Children living nearest the school	10
Total	30

The last child to secure a place fell within criterion **5**. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived **0.92** miles from the school.

After considering all on-time applications this school was full to the admission number.

Late applications could only be added to the waiting list.
