Allocation results

St Leo's & Southmead Catholic Voluntary Aided Primary School Serving the Community

The above named school was oversubscribed for entry to reception class in September 2020 (i.e. the school received more requests for places than the number of places available to offer)

As a voluntary aided school, the governing body of the school are responsible for setting and applying the oversubscription criteria (or the 'admission policy') in order to determine which children can be offered places and who can not.

The school has **30** places available – these places were allocated as follows:

1. Looked After children and previously Looked After Children	-
2. Baptised Catholic children who have a sibling in the school	5
3. Other children who have a sibling in the school	12
4. Baptised Catholic children resident in the parish of St Leo's	4

7. Children from other Christian denominations	-
8. Children of other faiths	-
9. Other children	-
Total	30

The last child to secure a place fell within criterion **5**. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived **0.413 miles** from the school (as the crow flies).

After considering all on-time applications this school was full to the admission number.

Late applications could only be added to the waiting list.
