

# September 2020 reception class intake

## Allocation results

### St Mark's Catholic Voluntary Aided Primary School

The above named school was oversubscribed for entry to reception class in September 2020 (i.e. the school received more requests for places than the number of places available to offer)

As a voluntary aided school, the governing body of the school are responsible for setting and applying the oversubscription criteria (or the 'admission policy') in order to determine which children can be offered places and who can not.

The published admission number for the school is **30** – places were allocated as follows:

Oversubscription Criteria (Admission Policy) <sup>1</sup>	Number of places allocated
1. Looked After children and previously Looked After Children	-
2. Baptised Catholic children who have a sibling in the school at the time of admission	<b>10</b>
3. Baptised Catholic children resident in the parish of St John Vianney (the part of the parish formerly referred to as St Mark's)	<b>7</b>
4. Other Baptised Catholic children	-
5. Non-Catholic children with a sibling in the school at the time of admission	<b>7</b>
6. Children from other Christian denominations	<b>3</b>
7. Children of other faiths	<b>2</b>
8. Other children	<b>1</b>
<b>Total</b>	<b>30</b>

The last child to secure a place fell within criterion **8**. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived **0.142 miles** from the school (as the crow flies).

**After considering all on-time applications this school was full to the admission number. Late applications could only be added to the waiting list.**
