### Secure Fencing Limited Awarded Small Business Growth Grant



Secure Fencing Ltd has expanded its product service thanks to a £2,300 Small Business Growth Grant from Knowsley Council's Business Liaison and Investment Team.

Secure Fencing was incorporated in 2011 by company Directors Dave and Cheryl Rainger. Trading from Lees Road, Knowsley Business Park the company manufactures and installs security fencing, gates and automated traffic barriers whilst employing 3 members of staff and 6 subcontractors on a regular basis.

Following other investments in the business, the company approached the Council for grant support towards the purchase of a Bandsaw. This investment would enable the business to manufacture steel fence posts,

which were currently bought in enabling the business to become more efficient and competitive in their field.

Director Dave said "We have wanted to invest in this equipment for quite some time but with funds being tied up in the business we required assistance; the grant enabled us to purchase the machinery which will now increase capacity on site saving the business time and money. We have now employed another member of staff and are looking forward to further growth."
