Ensuring a Choice of Travel Supplementary Planning Document

On 1st September 2010 the Council adopted the Ensuring a Choice of Travel Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) as part of the Knowsley Local Development Framework. The SPD supplements the “Saved Policies” of the Unitary Development Plan, adopted in June 2006, which is the statutory development plan for Knowsley. The SPD provides consistent guidance to developers on the access and transport requirements for new development across Merseyside.

The adopted SPD, together with the “saved policies” of Unitary Development Plan itself, will be used for development control purposes in determining planning applications within the Borough.

Halewood One-Stop-Shop, The Halewood Centre, Halewood
