

Info Sheet 4 – April 2025 Issue - Construction Phase 1

Following on from the consultation last year work has commenced on an Active Travel and Capacity Improvement Scheme on Moorgate Road and the East Lancashire Road (A580) This will help in providing a fit for purpose, high quality, resilient network for the future. Works will be undertaken in different phases with later works involving Junction 4 of the M57 motorway.

Works - Monday 28th April 2025 – Wednesday 04th June 2025

- Modifications to two pedestrian islands either side of the right-hand filter lane to accommodate an additional lane on Moorgate Road South.
- Extension of the Northern pedestrian island on the western arm of East Lancashire Road to allow for the installation of a speed on green camera
- Extension of the Southern pedestrian island on the Eastern arm of East Lancashire Road to allow for the installation of a speed on green camera
- Footway Works to enable a new segregated cycleway across western arm
- Traffic Signal, Street Lighting and Traffic Sign work and associated ducting infrastructure

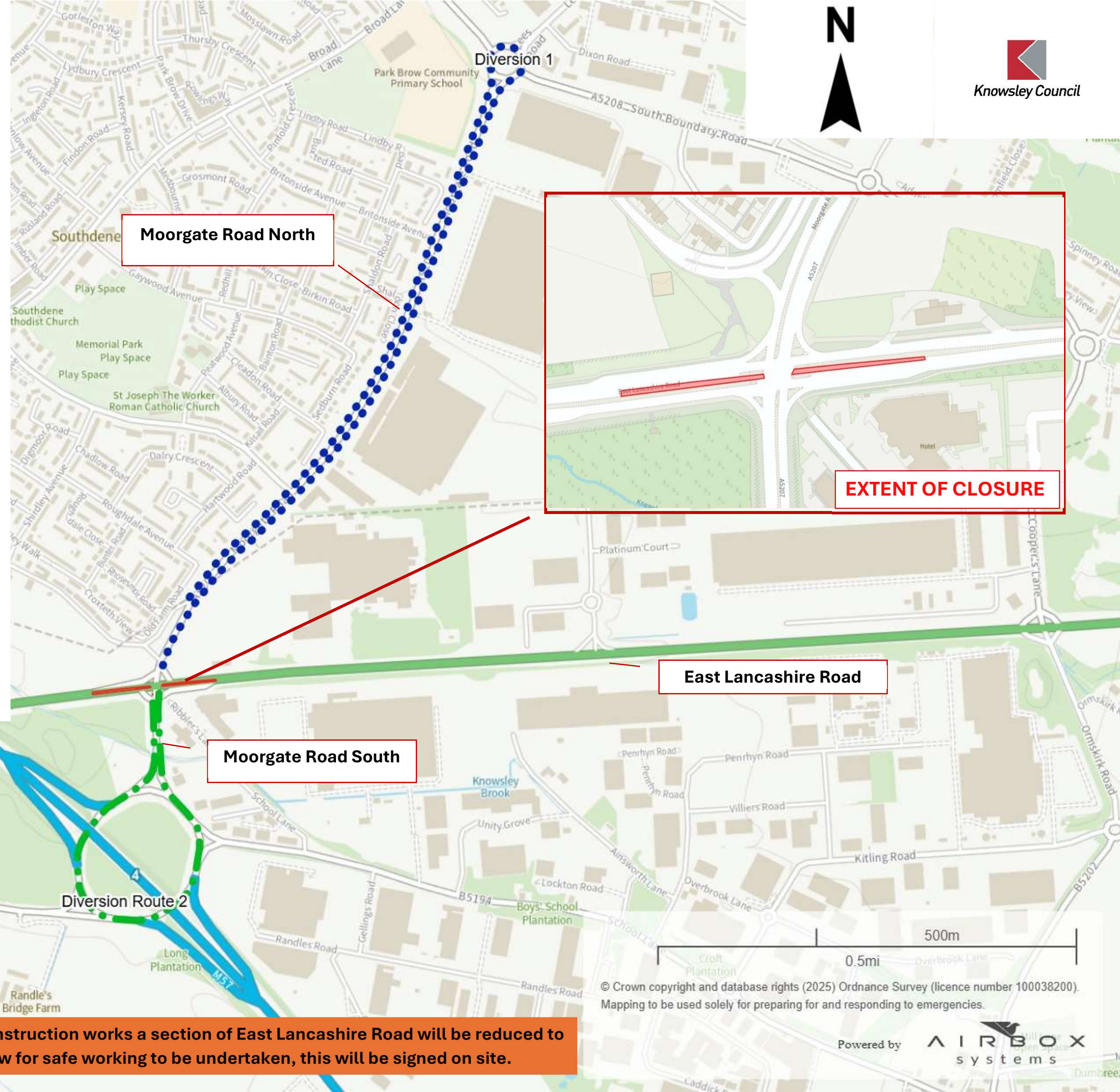
Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council (KMBC) has reviewed the traffic management and construction phasing arrangements. The durations outlined in this construction update and subsequent iterations are subject to change.



CENTRE ISLANDS - EAST LANCS E & W- TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ARRANGEMENT



- Moorgate Road North going south towards the junction will be reduced to two straight ahead lanes with the left filter lane remaining open
- East Lancashire Road going east towards St Helens will be reduced to one straight lane, the left filter lane will remain open, the right-hand filter lane will be closed, once the works on the Northern Island is complete the traffic management will be relaxed, and two-lane running will resume – Use diversion Route 1
- East Lancashire Road going west towards Liverpool will be reduced to one straight ahead lane, the left filter lane will remain open, the right-hand filter lane will be closed. – Use Diversion Route 2
- East Lancashire Road Western arm to be reduced to one lane for a short length until motorists are safely past the works.
- Moorgate Road South going north will be reduced to two lane, one straight ahead and one turn right lane
- The left turn from Moorgate South onto East Lancs Western arm will be prohibited for the full duration of the entire works.



During the construction works a section of East Lancashire Road will be reduced to 30MPH to allow for safe working to be undertaken, this will be signed on site.
