

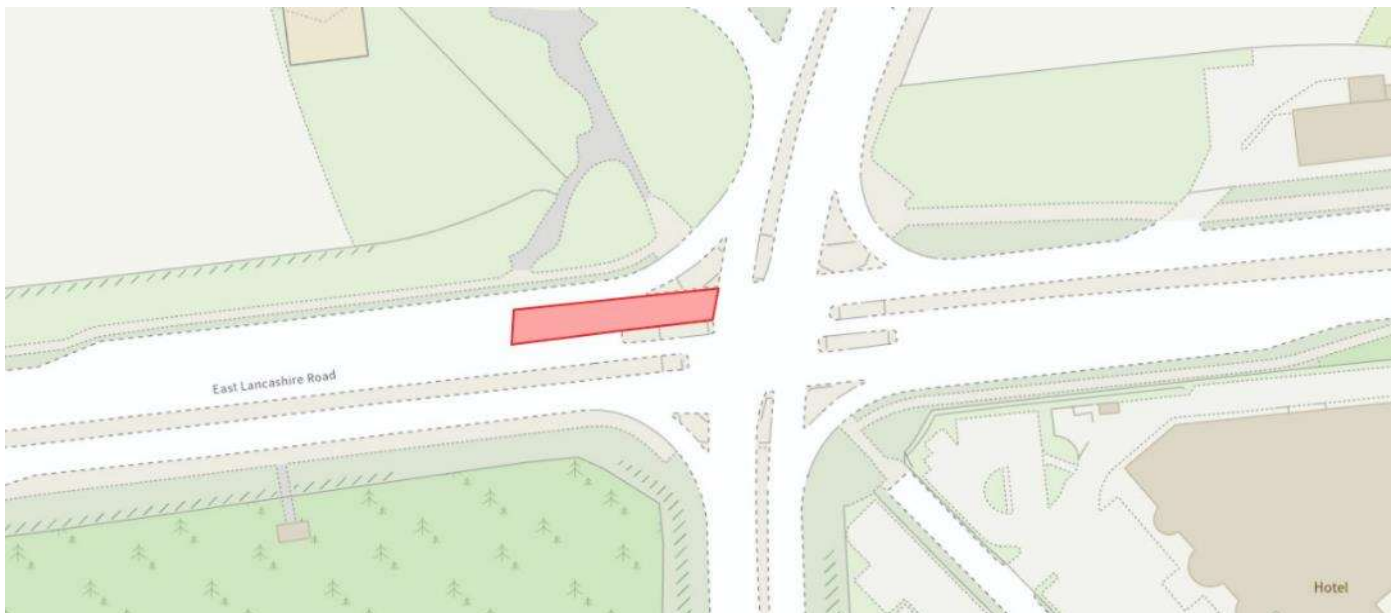
EAST LANCASHIRE ROAD EASTBOUND DIRECTION (TOWARDS ST HELENS) - ROAD CLOSURE- FRIDAY 9TH MAY FROM 7:00PM TILL 5:00AM

Works at the Moorgate Road and East Lancashire Road junction are progressing as scheduled. We are now moving into Phase 3 of the project, as previously communicated during the week commencing 31st March.

To carry out essential works for traffic signal infrastructure, excavation works across the carriageway at the junction will take place on **Friday 9th May**, which requires the **closure of the two straight-ahead lanes towards St Helens** from **7:00pm to 5:00am**.

During this closure, all closures associated with info sheet 1 & 4 will still be in place.

We appreciate your patience while we carry out these improvements and apologise for any inconvenience caused.

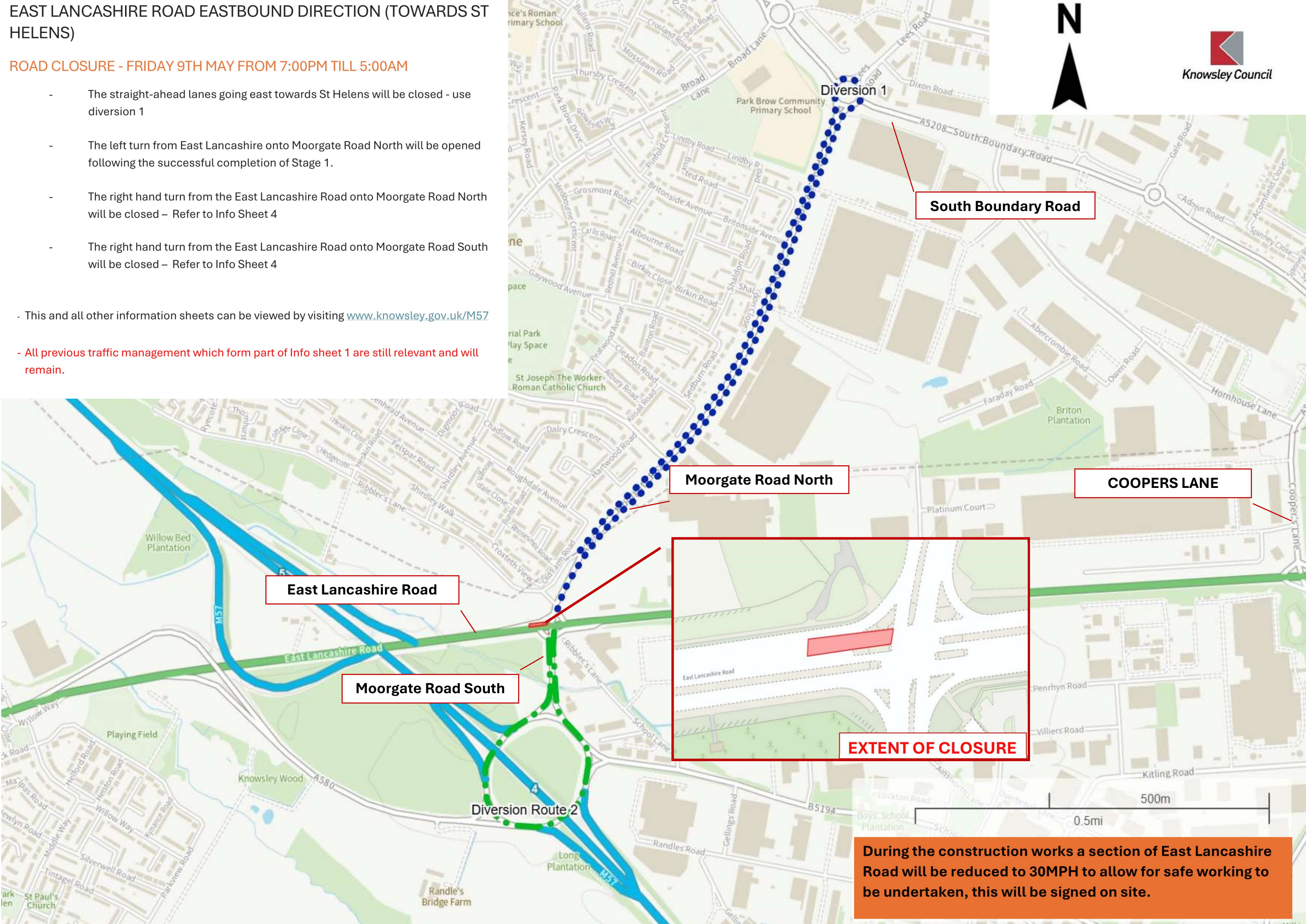

EAST LANCASHIRE ROAD EASTBOUND DIRECTION (TOWARDS ST HELENS)

ROAD CLOSURE - FRIDAY 9TH MAY FROM 7:00PM TILL 5:00AM

- The straight-ahead lanes going east towards St Helens will be closed - use diversion 1
 - The left turn from East Lancashire onto Moorgate Road North will be opened following the successful completion of Stage 1.
 - The right hand turn from the East Lancashire Road onto Moorgate Road North will be closed – Refer to Info Sheet 4
 - The right hand turn from the East Lancashire Road onto Moorgate Road South will be closed – Refer to Info Sheet 4

- All previous traffic management which form part of Info sheet 1 are still relevant and will remain.



During the construction works a section of East Lancashire Road will be reduced to 30MPH to allow for safe working to be undertaken, this will be signed on site.
