Future-proofing your network



Upgrading your network between Kirkby and Bootle

We're improving the electricity network across Merseyside to make sure it's ready for the future. As more people use electric cars and greener heating, demand is growing — and your network needs to keep up.

That's why we're investing £40 million to upgrade a key cable between **Kirkby and Bootle**. It's been in place since the 1960s, and this essential upgrade will help keep your electricity reliable, resilient, and future-ready.

What's happening in your area

From **9 August**, we'll be working along the eastbound side of the East Lancashire Road, between our substation near the A5208 and the M57 exit slip road. This part of the work has been agreed with Knowsley Council, and you'll see our teams working there from 9 August to 8 December 2025.

All the work being undertaken, along with the associated traffic management plan, have been agreed with Knowsley Council.

What we're doing

We'll be digging sections of the road to replace the old cables, connecting new ones to various points along your network.

You might see us digging and installing new cable ducts – around 25 to 40 metres a day – so we'll be moving on regularly.

Standard working hours will be 7am – 5pm, up to seven days a week.

What to expect

- One lane of the eastbound carriageway will be closed for safety
- Clear signs and diversion routes will be in place to keep traffic moving
- You may not always see activity sometimes we need to wait for materials to set before continuing

How this may affect you

- You'll still have access to homes and businesses
- If we're working outside your property, we might ask you to temporarily move vehicles
- No power cuts are expected during the work electricity supplies will stay on.


