NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council ("the Council") proposes to make the above-named order ("the Order") under Sections 1, 2, 4, 19, 32, 35, 45, 46, 47 53 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the 1984 Act").

If the Order comes into force the effect will be to prohibit any motor vehicle to proceed along Hillingden Avenue, Halewood from a point 22.5m south of its junction with Kenton Road for a distance of 1.5m in a southerly direction. Exemptions are provided for anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform and any motor vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency, and pedal cycles.
