**PROHIBITION OF WAITING - LEATHER'S LANE / BEECHWOOD AVENUE JUNCTION**

We are writing to inform you of proposed parking restrictions at the junction of Leather's Lane and Beechwood Avenue following an informal consultation that took place in July 2024.

The proposal involves introducing double yellow lines at the junction and extending them into Beechwood Avenue. These changes are intended to improve road safety in and around the area.

To proceed with this, a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) is required. The purpose of the TRO is to prohibit waiting at the junction which is essential for maintaining clear sightlines for both drivers and pedestrians. Vehicles parked near junctions can severely obstruct visibility, increase the risk of collisions and make it harder for drivers to see other vehicles, cyclists and pedestrians in time.

By removing parked vehicles near the junction, the proposed restrictions will significantly improve visibility for drivers, cyclists and pedestrians. This will help reduce the risk of collisions by eliminating common conflict points and ensuring clearer sightlines. The measures will also make it safer and easier for pedestrians to cross the road particularly children, older adults and those with mobility impairments. Overall, the changes will contribute to a safer, more accessible street environment and encourage greater levels of walking and cycling in the area.

The Traffic Regulation Order has been progressed and the decision has been made to proceed with introducing the above restrictions.

Please find attached a plan showing the extent of the proposed works.
