2026 Published Admission Number (PAN) = **240**

During the allocation of places, the Governing Body for Halewood Academy confirmed to the Local Authority, that they agreed to admit above the published PAN to a maximum of **250**.

A total of 444 applications naming the school as a preference were considered in the allocation of places

The Academy Trust are the admission authority of the school. The admission authority determine the admission arrangements, including the oversubscription criteria, which are applied to applicants to decide which children have priority for the places available.

250 places were allocated, as detailed below:

Oversubscription occurred within criterion 5. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived 1.509 miles from the school (as the crow flies).
