A total of 107 applications naming the school as a preference were considered in the allocation of places:

The Governing Body are the admission authority of the school, and they determine the admission arrangements. The admission committee of the school apply the oversubscription criteria from those arrangements to all applicants to decide which children have priority for the places available.

Places were allocated to PAN 45 as detailed below:

35 places are available within criterion group 2 and 10 places within criterion group 3.

In group 2, oversubscription occurred within criterion 2iii. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived 0.755 miles from the school (as the crow flies).

In group 3, oversubscription occurred within criterion 3ii. The distance tie-break was applied to all applicants within this criterion and the last child to secure a place lived 0.301 miles from the school (as the crow flies).
