

Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council – Design Quality in New Development Supplementary Planning Document

Adoption Statement – June 2023

An update to the Design Quality in New Development Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was adopted by Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council at a Cabinet meeting on 7 January 2016.

The SPD supplements the policies of the Knowsley Local Plan and provides consistent guidance for developers on the design of new development in Knowsley. It is a material consideration in decisions on planning applications

Any person with sufficient interest in the decision to adopt the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of that decision. Any such application must be made promptly and, in any event, not later than 3 months after the date on which the SPD was adopted.
