



Annual Progress Report Additional Highways Maintenance Funding 2018/19

Statement of Spend as at 31 March 2019

In the 2018 Budget the Chancellor of the Exchequer announced that the Government had allocated an additional £420 million in the 2018/19 financial year for local highways maintenance. This was to be spent on the repair of potholes and to keep local bridges and structures open and safe, as well as to help aid other minor highway works that may be needed.

The funding was distributed formulaically to all local highway authorities based on the Department for Transport's existing local highways maintenance capital funding formula. Through this, Knowsley Council was allocated an additional £821,000 to be spent between 2018 and 2019.

The following statement is made in compliance with the grant conditions for the additional highway maintenance funding and outlines how and where the funding was invested during 2018 to 2019.

Carriageway Patching - 2018 to 2019

Knowsley Council follows the recommendations of the Highways Maintenance Efficiency Programme Pothole Review and wherever possible seeks to implement the first time permanent repair of potholes. The additional funding contributed to the permanent repair of potholes at the following locations on Knowsley Council's highway network:

Drainage Works - 2018 to 2019

The additional funding was used to address drainage issues identified during the cyclical cleaning activities, such as non-running or problematic gullies causing flooding on the highway. In addition, approximately 200 damaged or unable to lift gully covers were repaired or replaced using this funding.
